Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

- why you went to France **and** what the journey was like
- what you thought of the areas you visited

- whether you would recommend this type of experience

You should write approximately 120–150 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Learning

Last year you went to France on an activities holiday with your school. During your stay you had the opportunity to try out some new sports and other activities. On your return you have been asked to write an account **in French** of your experience.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly you went in France **and** who you went with
- what new sports or activities you took part in
- how you got on with the others taking part
- whether or not you would recommend this kind of holiday to others

You should write approximately 120–150 words.
