Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Learning

You and your Spanish class took part in a ten-day language course at a school/college in Spain/a Spanish-speaking country. Whilst there, you stayed with a family.

You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- how you got there **and** what you thought of the journey
- how you got on with the family you stayed with
- what you learned at the school/college
- what extra activities you took part in
- what you thought about the places you visited
- if you would recommend a language course to others.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Employability

You and some students from your Spanish class went to Spain/a Spanish-speaking country on work experience for one month. You stayed with a family when you were there.

You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where you did your work experience **and** how you travelled there
- what you did for your work experience
- how you got on with your work colleagues
- what you thought about the places you visited
- what else you did during your stay
- how you think this experience will help you in the future.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
